



Light Distributions


Red, Elevated Stopbar Light

Coupling


CEDD type 797 elevated light fixtures can be delivered with a TKH frangible coupling:

• Type C (CEDD)

The TKH frangible coupling is calculated and tested to break at:

45 kgm ± 4 kgm which is in accordance with FAA AC 150/5345-46E and ICAO ADM Part 6.

For pole mounting of the CEDD type 797 elevated light fixtures, no coupling is required.






